## Chapter 2 <br> GBP Curriculum

### 2.1 List of Credits required for Graduation

In order to obtain the degree of Bachelor of Business Administration, students need to fulfill all the credit requirements specified below during their four years of attendance.

Courses offered in GBP are classified into three categories: (1) Liberal Arts Courses, (2) Business Administration Courses, and (3) Courses Offered by Other Programs. GBP students are required to earn 36 credits or more from the courses in the first category; 68 credits or more from the courses in the second category; 20 credits or less from the third category. In total, they need to earn 124 credits or more to graduate and to obtain a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.

${ }^{* 4}$ Class assignments are determined by students' proficiency level. Please register for the designated class.
${ }^{* 5}$ As for the Foreign Language Courses, students are required to learn Japanese. However, for those who are acknowledged by university to have reached a certain level of Japanese language skills at the time of entrance, the Foreign Language Courses are not compulsory. In that case, they need to acquire an additional 2 credits or more from the Upper Division Liberal Arts Courses (See 2.4). However, in that case, the required subtotal credits from the Liberal Arts Courses is still the same ( 36 credits or more).
${ }^{* 6}$ Even if students have acquired all the credits required for graduation by the end of the 3rd year, they need to take 8 credits or more during their senior year (excluding Qualification Courses (See 2.2)).
${ }^{* 7}$ Non-accredited courses are included in the International Volunteer \& International Internship Programs. Please contact the Global Education Center for further information.
${ }^{* 8}$ Students are allowed to register to acquire 12 subjects from the Japanese Language Program (JLP) without charge. Students are required to pay an extra fee(s) if they register to acquire a $13^{\text {th }} \mathrm{JLP}$ subject or more.
